What is a Community Land Trust (CLT)?

Community Land Trusts – or CLTs – are democratic, non-profit organisations that own and develop land and assets on them for the benefit of the community in perpetuity. They typically provide affordable homes, community gardens, civic buildings, pubs, shops, shared workspaces, energy schemes and conservation landscapes.



What is WACCLT?

Wirral Arts & Culture Community Land Trust - WACCLT - is a unique member led organisation with two clear aims. These are:

- to deliver ambitious and transformational arts programmes for the local communities of Wirral, with an emphasis on harnessing creative growth as a powerful source of individual and collective wellbeing.
- to acquire land and buildings which provide affordable and sustainable housing and studio/gallery/work space to enable Wirral artists and creatives to thrive, in perpetuity.



Why become a member?

WACCLT is a member-run community benefit society (a type of charitable co-operative) which will keep us rooted in our community. All who support our aims are welcome to join as members, including organisations and groups.

Gift Aid
